What facts can you find that tell us about fruit and fizzy drinks and if they're good for our bodies.

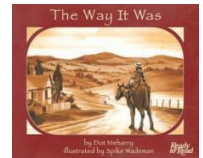
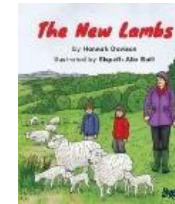


Reading – Look at Task3
